What is the Third Age?

The Third Age refers to the period of time after the First Age of childhood and the Second Age of full-time employment and parental responsibility.

Why are we called U3A?

U3A is short for University of the Third Age. We are a university in the original sense of the word: a collection of people devoted to learning with members (not students), all of whom are in their Third Age. The U3A is a unique and exciting organisation which provides life-enhancing and life-changing opportunities. Retired and semi-retired people come together and learn together, not for qualifications but for its own reward. Members share their skills and life experiences: learners teach and teachers learn, and there is no distinction between them.

Who can join U3A?

Anyone in the Third Age can join U3A, There is no lower age limitation and membership can include people who are working part time



Groups and Group Leaders

Group Leaders are the backbone of U3As and are ordinary members who have organised an activity group, usually held in a member's home. There are no qualification requirements just a willingness to learn and share with others. As a group you learn together. If you have a particular interest or expertise maybe you might consider leading your own group with help from our Group Co-ordinator. Together we can keep our minds and bodies active

In addition to local activities, there are holiday trips, lectures and workshops available from National and Regional Offices and the U3A also offers online learning and much, much more.

How are U3As Organised?

The U3As are democratic, self-funded, self-managed organisations which exist to provide a varied range of activities at minimum cost.
